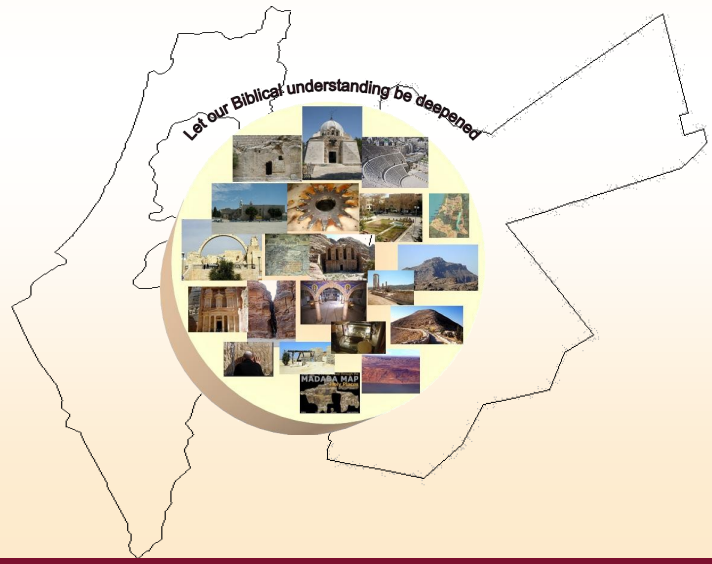

Inspire ME 2012 "11 day Vision trip to Israel and Jordan"

Day 1

Tuesday, April 17, 2012

Activity

We arrive at Ben Gurion Airport where we will be met by an Israeli guide who will be with us through our stay in Israel. We will travel north to our hotel near Netanya, a city along the Mediterranean. Our first evening will be a time to rest, walk along the sea front, and have a casual supper. This is also a time for personal devotions as the sun sets over the Mediterranean Sea.

Day 2

Wednesday, April 18, 2012

Activity

After an Israeli breakfast, we head north along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea, where the Gentiles first heard the Good News. Our journey will then head east to Mt. Carmel, where Elijah challenged King Ahab and the prophets of Baal. Moving further east we will stop in Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus, before beginning a two night stay in the Tiberius area along the Sea of Galilee.

Day 3

Thursday, April 19, 2012

Activity

Following breakfast we will visit the ruins of Capernaum's ancient synagogue and Peter's home. We travel to the site of the feeding of the 5000 and enjoy a devotional time reflecting on what God's Word teaches us about Himself through the experiences of Jesus and His disciples on the Mount of the Beatitudes. Following a relaxing cruise on the Sea of Galilee, we will return to our hotel in time to eat supper with our ministry partners, hearing how God is moving in Northern Israel.

Day 4

Friday, April 20, 2012

Activity

Our journey will begin with a stop at a baptismal site along the Jordan River. We will then move south to Beit Shean/Scythopolis, the most magnificent archeological site in Israel, located at the strategic juncture of the Jezreel and Jordan Valleys. Traveling along the Jordan River Valley, we will stop at Jericho before heading up to Jerusalem where we will stay for four nights.

Day 5

Saturday, April 21, 2012

Activity

Today is the Jewish Sabbath. We will walk where Jesus walked in the City of David - Jerusalem. We will experience the final hours leading up to His crucifixion, beginning with a panoramic view of the city from the top of the Mt of Olives. Walking through the ancient olive groves, we will take time for the reading of Jesus' prayer, and personal reflection. Our next visit will be to the House of Caiaphas where Jesus was beaten and spat upon. On our way into the Old City of Jerusalem we will pass the Wailing Wall at the foot of the Temple Mount. We will return to our hotel for supper and an evening with our Arab ministry partners telling how the ministry of the Cross of Jesus continues to free and transform lives.

Day 6

Sunday, April 22, 2012

Activity

Today is the Lord's Day. We will have a relaxing morning before we worship at the Old City Alliance Church.

In the afternoon there will be an optional excursion to the famous Zealots' mountain fortress, Masada. The cost for this trip is \$40. Those remaining in Jerusalem will have an opportunity to visit the Israel Museum, Yad Vashem (Holocaust Museum), or have a free afternoon.

Day 7

Monday, April 23, 2012

Activity

Today we will make our way up the Via Dolorosa to visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher and the Garden Tomb, believed to be the garden of Josef of Arimathea. Here we will celebrate the Lord's Table in front of an open tomb which could have been the burial site of Jesus. We will then re-enter the Old City in Jerusalem making our way towards the Temple Mount following what may have been the footsteps of Jesus as He came to the Temple. We will return to our hotel in time to eat supper with our Jewish ministry partners, followed by a time to hear how God is moving in the region of Jerusalem through Jewish ministry.

Day 8

Tuesday, April 24, 2012

Activity

Today we head towards Beersheba, the southernmost Israeli city on the edge of the Negev Desert. As we journey, our first stop will be just minutes outside of Jerusalem at the once humble birth place of the Prince of Peace - Bethlehem. From there we will come to the spacious Elah Valley where David fought Goliath. We will continue our trip to Beersheba, the city of wells dug by Abraham. After settling into our hotel we will have supper with our Jewish ministry partners and hear how God is moving among Jewish, Muslim, and Christians in the Negev region of Southern Israel.

Day 9

Wednesday, April 25, 2012

Activity

Today our destination is Petra. After breakfast we will board our buses, cross the Israel border and enter into the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan. After arriving in the Red Rose city of Petra, today called Wadi Mousa, we will settle into our Hotel. During supper and into the evening we will have an opportunity to hear from our IW'er's serving in the area, learning first-hand how God is transforming lives.

Day 10

Thursday, April 26, 2012

Activity

We will get up early, have breakfast and then head into the amazing mountain fortress inhabited by the Nabatians, Edomites - the descendants of Esau. We will walk into the hidden city carved into stone, through the narrow opening known as the Siq. We will see the Treasury, and many other wonders that make up Petra. In the distance we will be able to see Mount Hor, the burial site of Aaron. After leaving Petra we will journey the Kings Highway to Madaba, where the earliest surviving mosaics of the Holy Land may be seen. We then walk a few blocks to the Alliance Church, before continuing to Mt. Nebo, where from a distance Moses saw the Promised Land, and God buried him. Arriving in Amman, the capital city of Jordan, we will settle into our hotel for supper and a well needed rest. For those who wish to attend the Thursday evening service at the 2nd Circle Alliance Church, rides will be arranged.

Day 11

Friday, April 27, 2012

Activity

Our final full day will begin with an Arab buffet breakfast after which we will journey to Jerash, one of the cities of the Decapolis, and the best preserved Roman provincial town in the world. On our journey back to our hotel we will stop at the site where the Alliance Christian School of Jordan will be constructed and hear the vision God has given the church for this ministry. During supper and into the evening we will meet with our IW'ers and our Jordanian pastors and wives who will be sharing how God is working in Jordan.

Saturday, April 28, 2012

Activity

The morning will be a time for debriefing. We will worship God through praise, examine the questions He has shown us, note how He spoken to us, and ask what we will take away from this trip that will change our life. During the afternoon those taking excursions will depart to their partnership locations. Those returning directly to the US will have the afternoon and evening free before an early morning departure.
