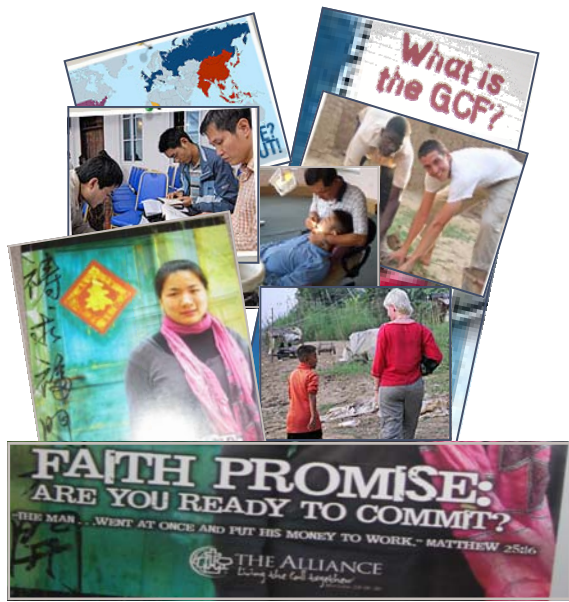
- TESL (Teaching English as a Second Language)

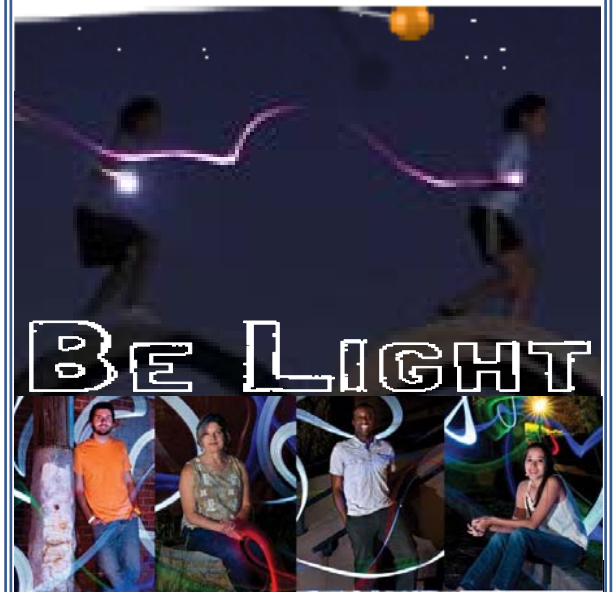
