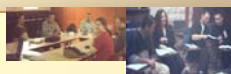

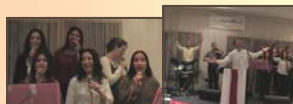

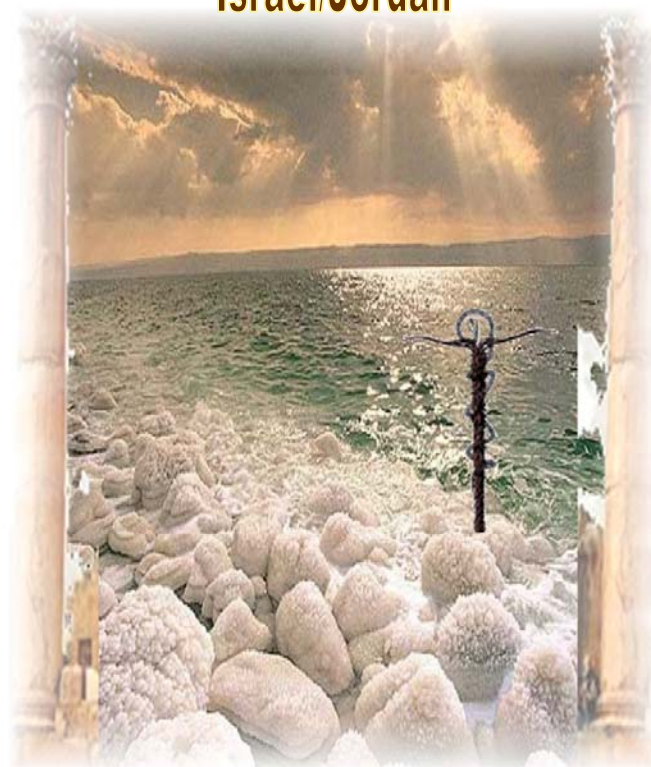

Inspire ME 2012 "10 day Vision trip to Israel and Jordan"

What is Inspire Me 2012? Inspire Me 2012 is a ten day trip to Israel, Jordan, and beyond in the Spring of 2012. During this trip you will have the incredible opportunity to deepen your intimacy with Jesus through on-site visits to places where Jesus walked, taught, prayed and brought the offer of salvation for all mankind. Following your ten day experience in the Middle East you will have opportunity to extend your trip to include other locations where Alliance believers are hard at work expanding the Kingdom.

Why Inspire Me 2012? Inspire Me 2012 is designed to personally connect you and your congregation in the Mid-Atlantic District with our Alliance workers and nationals in Israel, Jordan, and surrounding countries throughout the Middle East and Europe. Out of this trip you will link arms with Alliance workers through strategic partnerships, intentional prayer, and focused partner care. You will also have first hand interaction with Alliance workers, church leaders, and partner ministry leaders which will help you strengthen your resolve to build mutually productive partnerships.

Tiberius – Galilee
Jesus spent much of His time in the Galilee region of Israel. Capernaum was where He lived, and taught His disciples. In this region, Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount, fed the 5000, came to the disciples on the water, healed and preached. Jesus challenged His followers to actively live their faith before others.

Beth Shean
Known as Scythopolis in Jesus day, Beth Shean lies at the foot of Mt Gilboa. This city gives the most complete picture of life in a Gentile Galilean village at the time of Jesus.



Jerusalem – The City of David
Jerusalem, oh Jerusalem! This is the Holy City of Jews, Christians, and Muslims - the city that Jesus wept over, died in, and where He rose victoriously from the grave. Visiting the old and new cities of Jerusalem will inspire you to do all possible to bring back King Jesus. Here we will meet with Alliance ministry leaders.



The Garden Tomb
The Garden Tomb Association maintains this as the possible site for Christ's burial. We will have a Communion Service in front of the empty Tomb.

Amman
The capital city of Jordan is the center of Alliance ministries in Jordan. In Amman and the surrounding areas there are four Alliance churches, as well as the central office of the Alliance in the Arab lands. Hearing what God is doing through our Jordanian church family, at the risk of serious persecution, will be informative, and stimulating.



The Land of Moab
It was here that Israel spent 40 years in the wilderness. The Lord forbade Moses from entering the Promised Land, but he granted him a spectacular view of it before his death. God buried him and no man knew exactly where he was laid (Deut 34)..



Jerusalem Alliance Church



The Church exists in the middle of the Old City, in the Christian Quarter. The Jerusalem Alliance Church has many struggles, yet the Lord is sustaining her as a light in the darkness of this city. The Lord uses the church in several ways: in revival, outreach, and also

through an out-stretched hand of love to thousands of suffering Palestinians. Rev. Jack Y. Sara is the senior pastor of the church and working with him are men and women who are willing to be used by Jesus for proclaiming His glory.

Petra and the Land of Edom
Petra is also known in the Old Testament as Sela or rock. Our international workers from Aqaba will encourage us to join them in meeting the challenges and opportunities of living the Gospel witness in this spiritually dark region. Hear from our workers at the Life Center.

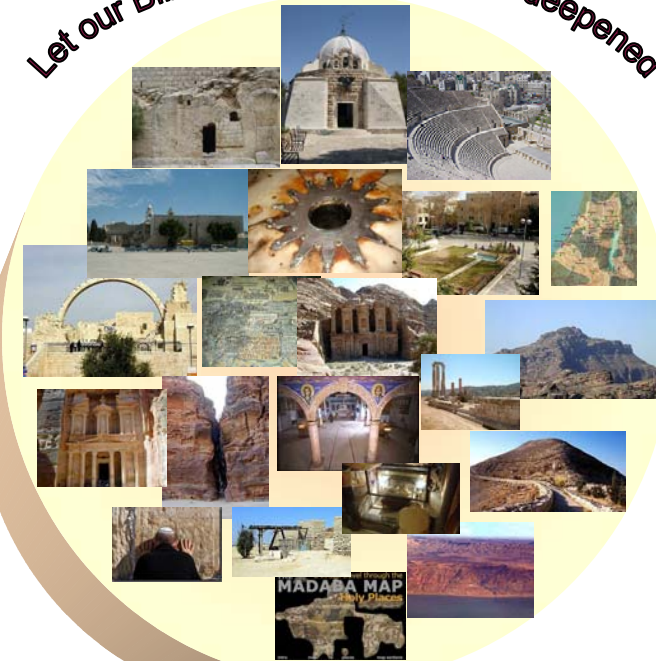


Beersheba - Arad
This city is the location where Abraham dug a well and entered a contract with Abimelech in Gen 21:31. It is also the center for Alliance ministries in the Negev. Ein Gedi - Masada
David hid from Saul and may have been inspired to write Psalm 23 from the canyons of Ein Gedi. We will visit the infamous Massad where Jewish Zealots stood to the last against the 10th legion of Rome.
