Global Mission—Open Doors

The theme for our fall 2010 – spring 2011 Missions Festival is: **OPEN DOORS**. The sub theme focus is: **OPEN DOORS to Lost and Hurting People**. This theme finds its Scriptural basis from:

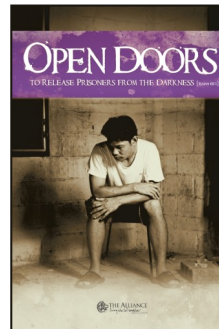
Isaiah 61:1:

The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners.

Colossians 4:3:

And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains.

OPEN DOORS to Lost and Hurting People takes the emphasis off of geography and onto people. Instead of portraying a specific location or initia-



tive, the “Open Doors” will reveal everyday ministry to the very people we’re called to reach—namely, the poor, brokenhearted, and those held captive by the powers of darkness. These people may be halfway around the world or just down the street.

Important tools to help you develop and tailor this theme for the missions festival will begin arriving at your church in July. Included will be a DVD with video clips telling the story of reaching the lost with the Gospel, encouraging the brokenhearted, or freeing the imprisoned. In addition to these videos, there will be graphics to help people catch the theme. There will be four posters and one banner built around the theme. Watch your mail for a packet from The Christian and Missionary Alliance which will contain these missions festival materials.
